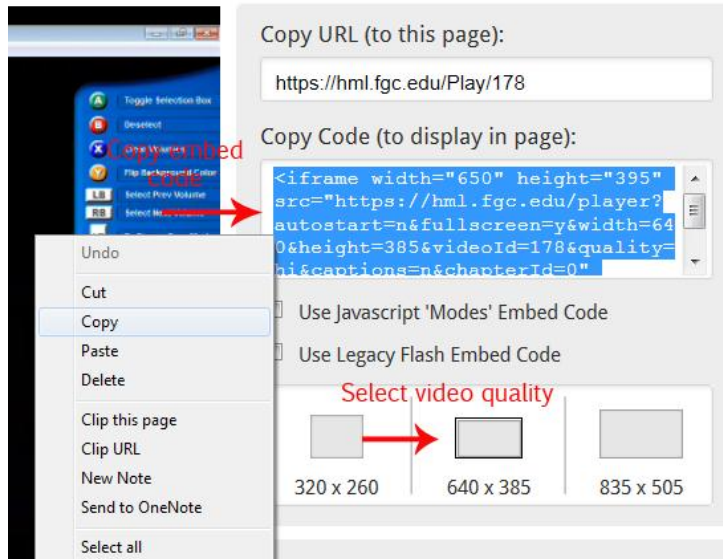


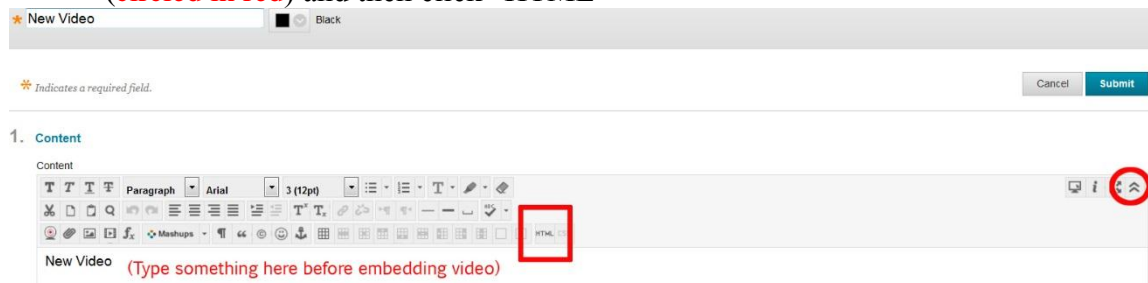
Embedding video in Blackboard from hml.fgc.edu or external websites like Youtube

Video can be embedded in blackboard using the standard Blackboard text editor.

- Go to the webpage that has the video you want to embed (illustration is from hml.fgc.edu) Select the video quality then right-click in the “Copy Code” field and select “Copy”.



- Go to your course in Blackboard and create a content item (assignment) and add something into the textbox (if you don't add some txt the videos will not display).
- Click the HTML button in the toolbar (red box in pic below). If you do not have this option click the chevron on the right hand side to expand to expand the tool (circled in red) and then click “HTML”



- This will bring up the HTML code view. Right click under the text that is already there and paste the embed code (image below). “Click update”



- You should now be back to the Blackboard content page. Click submit and you should be finished.

As a best practice you may want to "build content" as a "blank page" to prevents long assignment pages and loading times
