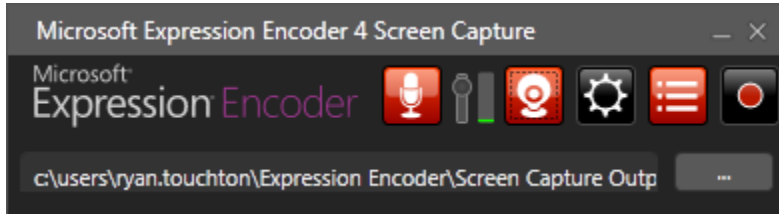


Go to the windows (start) menu and click “All Programs”.

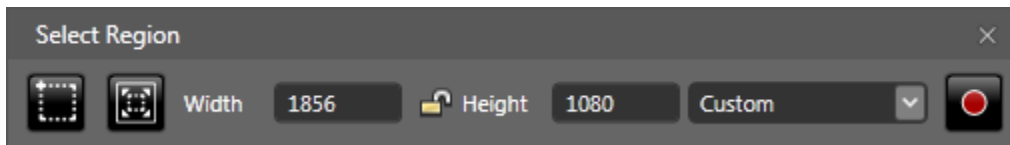
Expand the directory “Microsoft Expressions” and select “Microsoft Expression Encoder 4 Screen Capture”



Click on the microphone and webcam (if you also want video). When highlighted red they are selected. If you hover over the camera icon it will give you a preview.

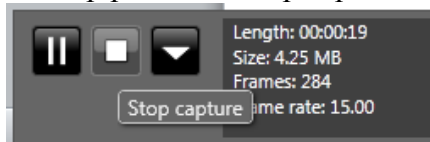
Click the record button on the far right. Select the region you want to record using the red box.

Click the record button again when you are ready to record.

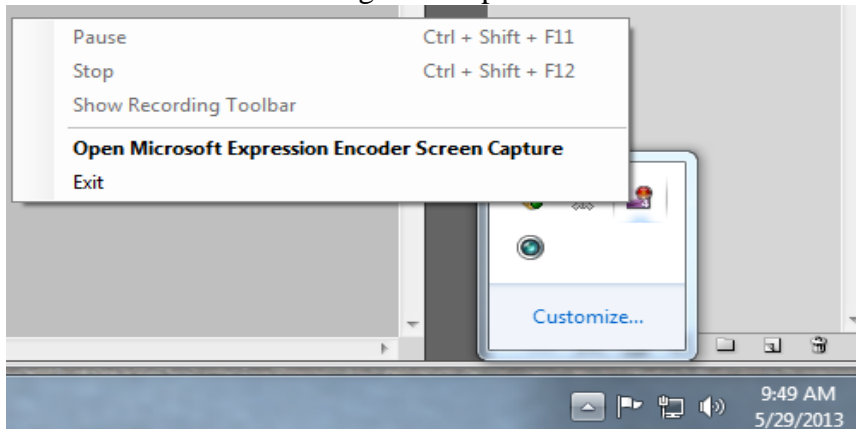


It will countdown from three and then start recording.

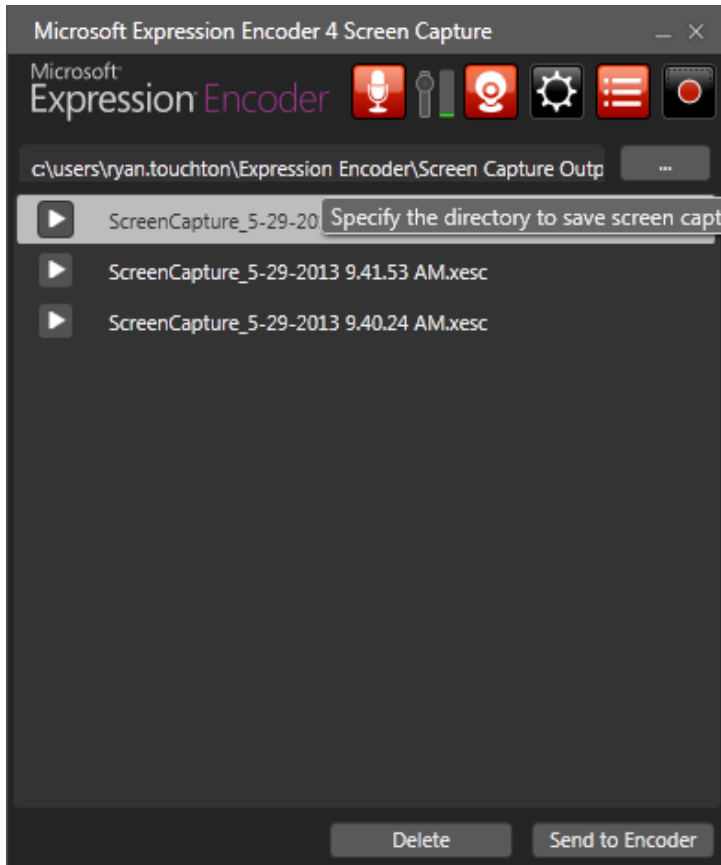
To stop press the “stop capture” button.



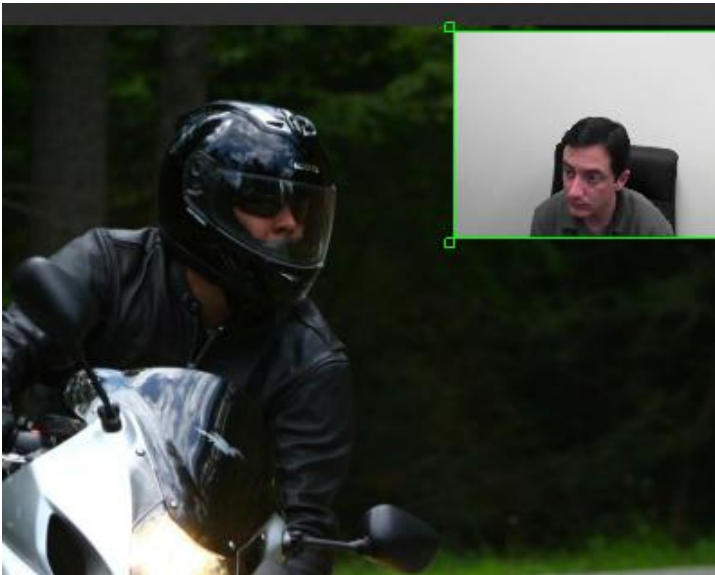
This can also be done through the Expression Encoder icon in the system tray.



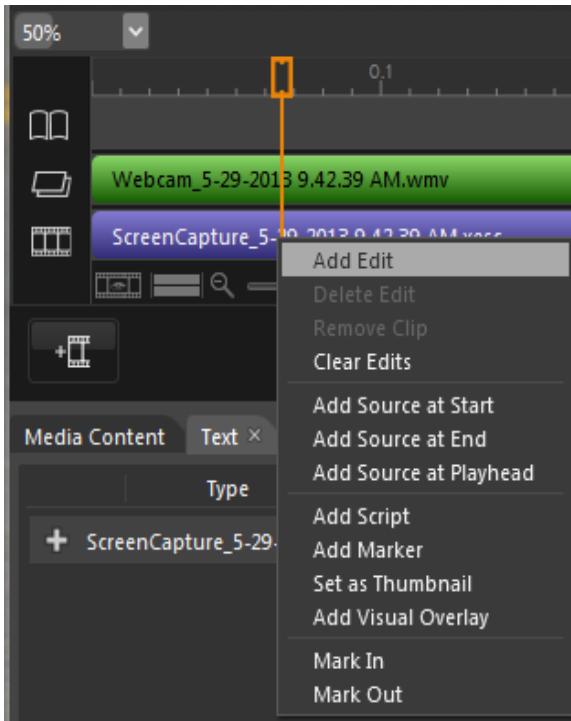
Select the video you just recorded and select “Send to Encoder”



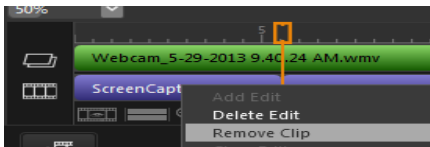
Resize and relocate webcam video using green box.



To trim sections of video out of your recording; right click on the purple bar and select “add edit”.



Move the orange marker to the area you want to delete, right click and select “Remove Clip”.



When finished select the file menu at the top and click “Encode”
